| Tint | Adding colour to white to make it lighter. |
| Hue | Dominant colour family |
| Tone | Light or dark of a colour |
| Warm / cold colours | Warm colours attract attention, cool colours create sense of space. |
| Viewfinder | Device useful for framing a composition. |
| Figurative | Representational artwork. It comes from a real object. |
| Opaque | Paint that covers and hides what is under them. |
| Translucent | Lets some light pass through. |
| Complimentary colours | Colours that contrast with each other when placed side by side. |
| Composition. | How things are arranged in a piece of art work. |
