In November 2025, we launched the Reading Plus intervention. This intervention is targeted at specific children, who are off the phonic program, to support with reading fluency, vocabulary and sight reading. Throughout the Autumn term, we spent time assessing the children so that they started on the right stage. After this, children brought home log ins for them to practice the tasks. The tasks are completed both at home and at school.
