<b>hunter-gatherers</b>	Mainly living by hunting, fishing and gathering wild fruit
<b>settlement</b>	A small number of people living together
<b>Iron Age forts</b>	A settlement built on a hill so that it was easier to defend against enemies
<b>Skara Brae</b>	The archaeological site found on the Orkney Islands in Scotland
<b>Stonehenge</b>	A famous Stone Age monument in Wiltshire
<b>archaeologists</b>	People who discover our history by looking at artefacts that have been found
<b>Iron ore</b>	A rock that has iron in it
