## Key Vocabulary

Shape	A shape is any 2D space.
Form	Form is linked to 3D shapes. It looks at height, width and depth.
Colour	Describes the object using detail.
Line	Can be 2D or 3D moving into a space.
Tone	Light and dark of a colour
Pattern	Lines, shapes form or colours are repeated.
3D (3 dimensional)	Something that has height, depth and width.
Space	Use of the area.
Shade	Adds black to a colour to darken it down.
Cross-hatching	Layering of multiple lines to achieve tone.
Viewpoint.	Where the artist is looking at.
